WISE WOMAN TO PLAY INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY SHOW IN MILTON KEYNES.

Power folk four piece Wise Woman will play a special International Women's Day show at The Stables, Milton Keynes on 7th March 2025.

Drenched with the "ridiculously perfect harmonies," (BBC Leeds) that have enchanted festivals from Glasgow's Celtic Connections to FolkEast, the show will include Wise Woman's signature original songs celebrating forgotten women of history, as well as an opportunity to hear new tracks from their forthcoming EP *Hold the Wonder*.

Wise Woman's "startling and shimmering" (Folk Wales) songwriting blend of folk, jazz, and musical theatre sounds, has also seen them win fans far and wide, from guesting on Radio 3's In Tune to opening for Radio 2 Folk Award Winners The Young Uns.

The band's open-minded approach to crossing musical genres reflects their individual music careers and diverse creative interest, with their musical history encompassing composing, performing, and directing. Such versatility has led to such collaborations as live gigs with artists Money and Arctic Monkeys, performing in classical chart topping Mediaeval Baebes, supporting the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, starring in musical theatre roles in the West End, and directing for English Touring Opera and Opera North.

Founder Anna Pool said, "It's essential that our sound world is as colourful and vibrant as the women who make it. That melting pot of influences represents a huge range of life experiences, everything we are as musicians and everything our subjects are."

Hold The Wonder, all songs of which audiences will hear in Milton Keynes, is a joy-laden, folk-harmony lathered EP, celebrating shapeshifting seal women, hollering for climate justice and proudly lifting the sparkling LGBTQ+ community of Colchester where the band hails from.

Wise Woman's previous EP release, *Thread*, was hailed as "a most exciting discovery of 2022," by Tom Robinson's Fresh on the Net blog and is described by the band as "From Fenland witches, to Boudicca, to the smoky underbelly of 1905 New Orleans, we transport audiences on a theatrical dream ride, through forgotten worlds and everyday treasures."

So what can Milton Keynes expect from this International Women's Day show at The Stables? Three quarters original songs from Hold the Wonder to Thread, plus one quarter covers with unique arrangements of everything from traditional American folk hymns, to psychedelic 70s jams. All in all, a huge celebration of power house women from history and beyond.
